Introduction

LinkTADs platform provides all relevant information about EU-China cooperation as well as ongoing and past activities in the EU and China regarding animal health research. It also provides an opportunity for the researchers to generate, join and contribute to discussions and new collaboration opportunities.

The aim of this guide is to provide new users with annotated illustrations and instructions to help them navigating and contribution to the following four main sections:

- (1) A section with information about the project, its activities and results; updated information collected from the EC, CAAS, the EU Delegation to China, the Euraxess links China network, etc.; a link library (checked regularly); and a news section including information on other projects, initiatives in China and the EU as well as relevant key events in Europe and China;
- (2) A searchable database of EU-China/animal health research programmes and projects;
- (3) A research corner for sharing open research results, reports, scientific articles together with a link to social media (LinkedIn groups where discussions will take place, Twitter or similar to share short news) ;case studies and interviews with researchers sharing their experience and benefits gained from EU-China cooperation;
- (4) A blog sharing the achievements and discussions in a more informal way (results from other projects, our workshops, training courses, personal comments on the short visits of the participating young researchers, etc).

The guide provides step-by-step assistance for interested researchers from Europe and China to make most of the platform.


Platform Features

The following features were specifically designed for the LinkTADs platform and allows registered users to make most out of the platform:

1. **Linking to social media**. The platform not only includes the references to LinkTADs social networks (Linkedin, Facebook, Twitter and weibo), but it also has a share tool, enabling users to share each page of the platform via their accounts on relevant social networks. Number of shares is displayed.



Discussions. Registered users can start a new discussion in the Epi-Lab Community section, discuss the uploaded documents as well as link to discussions from their accounts.

5. **Commenting.** Registered users can comment on discussions; all users (registered and public) can comment on the blog.




